This program aims to create a space for aspiring young environmental leaders from around the world who would like to immerse themselves through dynamic approaches in lectures, solutions, and ideas for developing environmental concepts.

What is ESummer?

ESummer is a Hybrid Summer Program organized by ENTER International in Bassano del Grappa, Italy, focused on technology in conjunction with sustainability. The program is divided into multiple case studies, informal discussions, lectures, and trips that promote cultural exchange between students and local people. In our last edition we had more than 800 applicants coming from 53 different countries with Brazil, India and Nigeria as the main representatives.

WHO ARE WE LOOKING FOR?

In the 2023 edition we are looking for young enthusiasts and young leaders from different nations and communities who want to change their reality through education, social impact and critical thinking, as well as to enrich their knowledge in sustainability and innovation.

DISCLAIMER ON TRANSPORTATION COSTS:

Please note that since our scholarships covering transportations are extremely limited, when applying, students should prepare to cover at least their travel expenses. Our Admissions committee is also working towards possible hotel fee waivers through residence with locals. If available this option will be notified in order to apply.

NEED-BLIND POLICY AND FEE WAIVERS

For students with demonstrated financial need, we strive to ensure that cost of attendance will not prevent anyone from participating in the ESummer. We consider demonstrated financial need separately from applicant eligibility.

This means that a student who is not able to pay for our In-Person program (Either it being the tuition, hotel or transportation costs) even after aid and scholarship, will be automatically transferred to the Online Version and required to sign an additional transfer confirmation forms/agreement.

Notice that Fee waivers for the Participation fee are available upon request after admissions.

ESTIMATED COST

The costs reported below are an estimate of the expenses for the year of 2023/2024 for the Venetian ESummer Program. These costs might vary but our administration strives to keep them as limited as possible.

*The Non-Refundable confirmation costs will be detracted from the total costs. Example: If a prospective student must pay 100€ total and pays the Non Refundable confirmation costs of 50€, the next and last payment shall be of 50€ as well.

** The Tuition costs might vary based on one's demonstrated financial need, while the accommodation(boarding) costs vary based on the number of scholarships available and the amount of students applying for them.
